Free time (free flow) Infection Control	Children	Spread of Infection due to close contact	 Children informed again of the importance of social distancing whilst outside. Nursery will use an independent classroom and have access to an independent outdoor area. Reception will use independent classroom and have access to make and create room. Toilets will be accessed in class setting. Nursery will use disabled toilet. Supervising staff must keep a 2 metre distance from each other as reasonably practicable. 	L	Y	



Refreshments for children Infection Control	Staff Children	Spread of Infection due to close contact	 Children will sit in small groups and where possible sitting at least 2 metres apart (consider placing dots/circles on the floor) Wash hands thoroughly before and after preparation of toast. Follow all normal practices for safety hygiene and food preparation. Ensure the kitchen surfaces have been wiped down with a mild disinfectant before and after preparing snacks and drinks. Following clearing up follow same hand washing procedure before and after picking up / disposing of leftover food. Wash all utensils in hot soapy water. 	L	Y	
Use of school resources in individual bubbles	Staff Pupils	Infection Control	 Where possible keep the use of resources to each allocated bubble. Resources to be rotated on a 3 day basis as prior to normal class sizes. Reception and nursery pupils will not have an individual resource pack. all classroom based resources i.e. books and games should be cleaned regularly along with all frequently touched surfaces. Use of school resources shared between bubbles or classes	Staff Pupils	Infection Control	Shared resources between bubbles or classes should be cleaned frequently and meticulously and always between bubbles, or rotated to allow them to be left unused and out of reach for a period of 48 hours (72 hours for plastics) between use by different bubbles. Use of Supply teachers and other staff	Staff Pupils	Risk of Infection	 Inform supply staff of the arrangements in place Consider using longer assignments for supply teachers and/or other staff Where possible minimise their movement around school and keep them in the same bubbles 	L	Y	



Before and After school clubs Wrap around Care	Pupils Staff	Infection Control	 Schools should consider resuming any breakfast and after-school provision, where possible, from the start of the autumn term Where possible keep pupils in their year groups or bubbles Where not possible look at consistent small groups only. Arrange for same staff to deliver before and after care provision to reduce risk. 	Low	Y	
Keeping the environment well ventilated	Pupils Staff	Infection control	 Ensure natural ventilation – opening windows where safe to do so (in cooler weather windows should be opened just enough to provide constant background ventilation 	Low	Y	
Malleable Materials	Pupils Staff	Infection control	 Children wash their hands thoroughly before and after messy play. Frequently touched surfaces, equipment, tools and resources for messy play are thoroughly cleaned and dried before they are used by a different group of children. Materials for messy play can be used and replaced. Malleable materials such as sand should be changed according to the manufacturer's instructions where applicable. 	Low	Y
