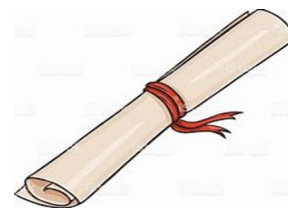

We have had a range of complaints from our neighbours on Dresden Close.

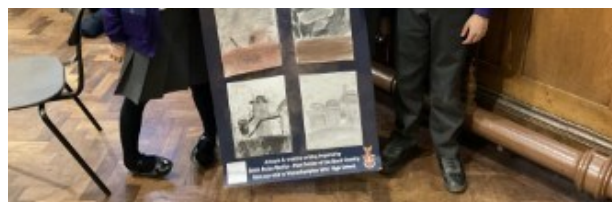
Please be Safe and respectful when parking and dropping the children at school and consider the impact of parking around the 'no park areas' or in front of peoples drives.
