Remember there is a 20mph speed limit for a reason.



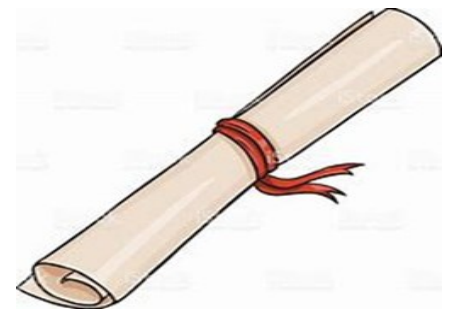
